

# NOTICE OF RACE

## 2019 QUEENSLAND ARROW & ARAFURA CADET CHAMPIONSHIPS

### 1.0 RULES

1.1 The Organising Authority for the Regatta is the Queensland Arrow Catamaran Association (QACA) in conjunction with the Moreton Bay Boat Club (MBBC).

1.2 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in "The Racing Rules of Sailing" (RRS), prepared by "World Sailing".

1.3 The Class rules of the Arrow and Arafura Cadet classes shall also apply.

### 2.0 VENUE

2.1 Racing will be conducted from the Moreton Bay Boat Club. The course will be located in the waters of Deception Bay.

### 3.0 ADVERTISING

3.1 Advertising shall be as defined by World Sailing Regulation 20. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority. The Organising Authority reserves the right to refuse advertising on a boat or competitor when it is in conflict with an event sponsor or the laws of the Australian or Queensland governments.

### 4.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 The Regatta is open to all boats of the Arrow and Arafura Cadet classes. Competitors must be current members of a State Arrow Catamaran Association. All competitors must be financial members of a sailing club currently affiliated with Australian Sailing.

4.2 Eligible competitors shall enter by completing and returning the attached Entry Form.

### 5.0 FEES

5.1 Required fees are:

Senior Arrow	\$60
Junior Arrow	\$40

### 6.0 RACING SCHEDULE

DAY/DATE	EVENT	TIME OF WARNING SIGNAL
Friday 19 April 2019	Invitation race	1400 hours
Saturday 20 April 2019	Racing	1200 hours
Sunday 21 April 2019	Racing	1000 hours

#### 6.1 Notes

6.1.1 A maximum of 6 races shall be sailed.

6.1.2 No more than 4 races shall be sailed on any day.

6.1.3 No warning signal shall be made after 1400 hours on Sunday 21 2019.

## **7.0 MEASUREMENT**

7.1 Every boat shall have a current Measurement Certificate.

7.2 Boats may be checked for compliance at any time during the Regatta at the discretion of either the Race Committee or the QACA.

## **8.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

8.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at the time of Registration.

## **9.0 COURSES**

9.1 Both long and short races may be scheduled. Long races will be set up to have a duration of approximately 75 minutes. Short races will have a duration of approximately 45 minutes.

9.2 Course diagrams, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be left will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

## **10.0 PENALTY SYSTEM**

10.1 Rule 44.1 is amended so that the "two turns penalty" is replaced by a "one turn penalty".

## **11.0 SCORING SYSTEM**

11.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A shall apply.

11.2 Four races (4) are required to be completed to constitute a series, in which case a boat's series score will be the total of all her races. When 5 or 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **12.0 SAFETY**

All competitors shall wear a personal flotation device that is in a good condition and in accordance with the specifications issued or approved by a national authority or standards organisation and branded in the country of origin. Attention is drawn to Rule 1.2 (PFDs) and Rule 4 (Decision to race)

**13.0 OUTSIDE HELP**

13.1 Competitors the subject of actions of the Race Committee in retrieving crews from the water and returning them to their boats may not be penalised.

**14.0 RACE COMMUNICATION**

14.1 Whilst on the water, a competitor shall not carry equipment capable of making or receiving radio transmissions, except for equipment provided by the Organising Authority. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

**15.0 PRIZES**

15.1 Prizes shall be awarded as follows:

Arrow Invitation Race 1 <sup>st</sup> place	Arafura Cadet 1 <sup>st</sup> place
Outright - 1 <sup>st</sup> to 3 <sup>rd</sup> places	Outright - 1 <sup>st</sup> place
Handicap - 1 <sup>st</sup> place	Handicap - 1 <sup>st</sup> place
Veteran - 1 <sup>st</sup> place	
Junior - 1 <sup>st</sup> place	

**16.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

16.1 Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk – see Rule 4, Decision to race.

16.2 The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the Regatta.

**17.0 INSURANCE**

17.1 Every participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million. All owners/competitors who sign the Entry Form are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.

**18.0 AMENDMENTS**

18.1 Any amendment to this Notice of Race will be posted on the official Notice Board in the MBBC.
