

NOTICE OF RACE

2022-23 AUSTRALIAN ARROW & ARAFURA CADET CHAMPIONSHIPS

1.0 RULES

1.1 The Organising Authority for the Regatta is the Meningie Sailing Club (MSC) on behalf of the South Australian Arrow Catamaran Association Inc.

1.2 The Regatta will be governed by the rules laid out in the current edition of "The Racing Rules of Sailing" (RRS), prepared by "World Sailing".

1.3 The Class rules of the Arrow and Arafura Cadet classes shall also apply.

2.0 VENUE

2.1 Racing will be conducted from the Meningie Sailing Club. The course will be located on the waters of Lake Albert.

3.0 ADVERTISING

3.1 Advertising shall be as defined by World Sailing Regulation 20. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority. The Organising Authority reserves the right to refuse advertising on a boat or competitor when it is in conflict with an event sponsor or the laws of the Australian or South Australian governments.

4.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 The Regatta is open to all boats of the Arrow and Arafura Cadet classes. Competitors must be current members of *Australian Sailing* via an affiliated Club or Association.

4.2 Eligible competitors shall enter by completing and returning the attached Entry Form.

5.0 FEES

5.1 Required fees are:	Senior (both classes)	\$300

6.1 Notes

6.1.1 Race times shall be at the discretion of the Race Officer and shall be notified by 1700 hrs on the prior day.

6.1.2 A maximum of 8 races shall be sailed.

6.1.3 No more than 3 races shall be sailed on any day.

7.0 MEASUREMENT

7.1 Sail measuring shall take place at the Club from 900 hrs on Thursday 29 December.

7.2 Every boat shall have a current Measurement Certificate.

7.3 Boats may be checked for compliance at any time during the Regatta at the discretion of either the Race Committee or the SAACA.

8.0 ARAFURA CADET ARRANGEMENTS

8.1 All Arafura Cadets shall sail in a single division.

8.2 Arafura Cadets with "wide head" mainsails shall comply with the Restrictions dated 30 June 2015. Arafura Cadets with the traditional mainsails shall comply with the Restrictions dated 13 December 2010.

8.3 When calculating overall results, Arafura Cadets with wide head sails shall be rated at 101, whilst those with traditional sails shall be rated at 104.

9.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

9.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at the time of Registration.

10.0 COURSES

10.1 Course lengths and course diagrams, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be left will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

11.0 SCORING SYSTEM

11.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A shall apply.

11.2 Four races (4) are required to be completed to constitute a series, in which case a boat's series score will be the total of all her races. When 5 or 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When 7 or 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12.0 SAFETY

All competitors shall wear a personal flotation device which is in a good condition and in accordance with the specifications issued or approved by a national authority or standards organisation and branded in the country of origin. Attention is drawn to Rule 1.2 (PFDs) and Rule 4 (Decision to race).

13.0 RACE COMMUNICATION

Whilst on the water, a competitor shall not carry equipment capable of making or receiving radio transmissions, except for equipment provided by the Organising Authority. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14.0 PRIZES

Prizes shall be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

The following Perpetual Trophies shall be presented provided there are sufficient eligible competitors:

Arrow: Outright; Handicap; Veteran; Junior

Arafura Cadet: Outright; Handicap

15.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

15.1 Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk – see Rule 4, Decision to race.

15.2 The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the Regatta.

16.0 INSURANCE

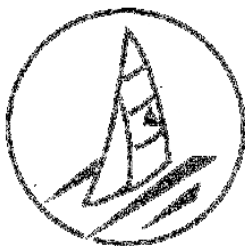
16.1 Every participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million. All owners/competitors who sign the Entry Form are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.

17.0 AMENDMENTS
